

They interviewed family members and friends to establish the time, place and circumstances of her birth. Next they tracked down an emergency room doctor in Tennessee, who was in the room when she was born. With all the evidence Paul Hastings presented, the judge did not hesitate to grant Diana a birth certificate. She was so relieved and excited to have the freedom to take next steps toward her adult life.

"These are extraordinarily bright kids. They are driven and make their communities better with their spirit," said Sarah Kelly-Kilgore of Paul Hastings. "You see these young people walk away from court feeling lighter and excited. They have such difficult backgrounds and to see them have this joy is why we get involved."
