On Tuesday, June 4, the Alliance completed a very special adoption for an at-risk youth just days before his 18th birthday! This was only the third time in L.A.'s history than an adoption took place for a youth in probation--and only the eighth throughout the U.S. The Alliance is part of a permanency collaboration with the delinquency courts, Los Angeles County Probation and the Department of Children and Family Services. The effort was launched in 2005 in order to give youth like Fred Jingles (pictured above) the opportunity to live in a safe, stable and loving home through adoption.

Fred entered foster care in 2009 because of his mother's substance abuse and his father's terminal illness. At 13, Fred struggled with these incredible life changes and began acting aggressively and was eventually arrested for assaulting a classmate. Fred spent eight months in juvenile hall and was released to the care of his aunt and uncle who expressed the desire to adopt him. Two persistent years later, Rondia and LaVetta adopted Fred.

It's amazing what can be accomplished when government agencies, the court and legal advocates come together for one unified goal: to give children a
