Suggestions for Bequest Verbiage

You may include a bequest to support the Alliance for Children's Rights when preparing your will or living trust, or by adding a codicil to your present will or living trust. Bequests may be of cash, securities, bonds, real estate, copyrights, royalties or other property. Bequests of all sizes are welcome, whether they are outright, contingent or residual.
